Dear Participating Contractors and Interested Parties:

This announcement is to explain pertinent details regarding Long Island transition deadlines for NYSERDA's free-reduced-cost audit program through Home Performance with ENERGY STAR (HPwES) and a clarification on the Assisted HPwES subsidy expiration date.

- Green Jobs - Green NY Audit Customers in PSEGLI electric territory:
 - Customers wishing to apply to NYSERDA's free/reduced-cost audit program must submit their application by 12/31/2016.
 - Reservation numbers must be claimed by January 31, 2017. Any reservation number not claimed by that date will be cancelled.
 - All reservation numbers will continue to have a 90 day approval period and no extensions will be granted for new applications that come in after December 13, 2016.
 - Contractors must strictly adhere to the current deadlines and all audits must be completed and incentives claimed by April 15, 2017.
- Clarification: Assisted HPwES Projects in PSEGLI electric territory
 - Last week's announcement explained the customer's subsidy expiration date remains at 180 days. Any extensions requested will be limited to no later than June 30, 2017.
 - Remember that you must submit all worksopes to CLEAResult by January 14, 2017. Worksopes must be completed and submitted to CLEAResult within the 90-day workscope approval timeline.
