



Dear Participating Home Performance Contractors,

NYSERDA has updated the **Eligible Measures list** and the **Insulation Rules** document with an effective date of June 16, 2015.

In relation to the Insulation Rules update, a **Technical Bulletin** is also being released on **Dense Packing of Roof Assemblies**, effective immediately.

Highlights of these changes follow below.

Major changes to the **Eligible Measures** list are:

Boiler - Gas Condensing - AFUE 90%

Boiler - Oil Condensing - AFUE 87%

Boiler - Non-Condensing - AFUE 85% (projects must include boiler reset control)

With this update, the **Insulation Rules** now encompass over 90% of our historical cases. If a measure falls outside of the rule or it is an insulation type that does not have a rule, then the insulation is only eligible for a loan (subject to cost effectiveness rules). There is no Total Resource Cost (TRC) screening option. Measures not covered by the rule are ineligible for HEMI or subsidy.
