



Dear Participating Home Performance Contractors and Program Partners,

NYSERDA is pleased to announce that the NY Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® Program has added seven measures prequalified for the 10% High Efficiency Measure Incentive and 50% Assisted Subsidy. These measures include:

<u>Eligible Measure</u>	<u>Requirements</u>
Duct Insulation	Installed in accordance with all applicable state and local codes
Heat Pump Water Heater	50 gallons, EF $\geq$ 2.2, ENERGY STAR Qualified. Must be installed in an unconditioned space
On Demand Water Heater, Natural Gas	ENERGY STAR Qualified, EF $\geq$ 0.82, GPM $\geq$ 2.5 over a 77°F rise, <2 gallons storage, <200,00 BTU. Must replace a conventional 40 or 50 Gallon tank
Storage Tank Water Heater, Natural Gas	ENERGY STAR Qualified, 40-100 gallons, EF $\geq$ 0.67, FHR $\geq$ 67 gallons per hour, <75,000 BTU
LEDs	All ENERGY STAR Qualified bulbs. Must replace an incandescent bulb
Boiler Reset Controls	Programmed properly per manufacturer's specifications and site conditions. (\$250 price cap increased to \$500.)
Thermostats	One per zone. (Previously one per dwelling unit)

In addition, the incentive rules for insulation in natural gas and electrically heated homes have expanded to include attic slopes.

#### **Maximum Pre-Existing and Post Installation Insulation Levels by Building Component**

Building Component	Maximum Effective R-Value of Pre-Existing Insulation	Maximum Post Installation Insulation
Attic Floor without Decking	R-15 Statewide	Cellulose and Fiberglass - R-60 State Spray Foam - R-49 Statewide
Attic Floor with Decking	R-8 Statewide	R-30 Statewide

Exterior Wall	R-5 Statewide	R-13 Statewide
Attic Slope	R-5 Statewide	R-19 Statewide
Basement or Crawlspace Ceiling	Site Specific TRC Analysis to be Conducted
