



Dear Home Performance Contractors:

Governor Cuomo launched Renewable Heat NY (RHNY) in early 2014 to encourage the expansion of the high-performance biomass heating market and raise consumer awareness, support the development of advanced technology heating products, develop local sustainable heating markets and encourage the use of this renewable fuel. As part of the RHNY initiative, the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® Program will be able to provide incentives toward the purchase and installation of residential pellet stoves. The initial phase of this initiative targets the replacement and recycling of 150 wood or pellet stoves through replacement with pellet stoves at a total incentive of \$1,000 per installed and recycled unit. The particulate matter output of pellet stoves installed through this initiative is intended to be industry leading at 2.0 grams per hour (PM 2.0 g/h).
