NYSERDA and CLEAResult are pleased to announce the release of the [NYSERDA Residential Existing Homes Learning Management System](#) (LMS). The LMS is a web-based application through which participating contractors and their staff will be able to access program specific courses and trainings as well as sales, technical and quality assurance topics. Many courses will be eligible for Building Performance Institute (BPI) Continuing Education Credits (CEUs).



The LMS will be available at no cost to all participating Home Performance with ENERGY STAR and EmPower New York contractors beginning March 7, 2018. The primary program contact listed on your Participation Agreement will receive an email with a link to the LMS which will contain the registration and program codes for users to create a new account. It is expected that the primary contact will share this information with their staff so that they can create their own accounts.

A webinar will be held to demonstrate the LMS. It will include how to log in, navigate around the system, view your personal details and enroll in a course.
