In the spring of 2018, NYSERDA issued RFQL3695 requesting responses from qualified Quality Assurance service providers to develop and implement quality initiatives in support of several NYSERDA residential and clean energy programs. Through that process, NYSERDA approved several proposers to provide support for quality services for more than one program category in multiple services regions. IBTS and Honeywell were two of the proposers selected.



Effective October 1st, 2018, both IBTS and Honeywell will start completing inspections as a third-party Quality Assurance Service Contractor providing field inspections for NYSERDA's Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® and EmPower New York programs throughout New York State. New York State will be separated into two regions.

Honeywell will cover Region 1. Region 1 consists of: Niagara, Erie, Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, Allegany, Steuben, Schuyler, Yates, Ontario, Livingston, Genesee, Orleans, Monroe, Wayne, Wyoming, Seneca, St. Lawrence County, Jefferson County, Lewis County, Oswego County, Onondaga County, Oneida County, Madison County, Chenango County, Broome County, Tioga County, Chemung County, Cortland County, Tompkins County, Cayuga County, Ulster, Sullivan, Dutchess, Columbia, Greene, Delaware, Otsego, Herkimer, Franklin, Clinton, Essex, Hamilton, Warren, Washington, Fulton, Montgomery, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Albany, Rensselaer, Orange, Putnam.

IBTS will cover Region 2. Region 2 consists of the remaining counties in New York State.
