





Referral distribution to contractors is based on the following criteria:

- 1. Participating Contractor Status in the Program
- 2. Contractor Referrals
- 3. Geographic Territory
- 4. Contractor Capacity
- 5. Participating Contractor Quality Assurance (QA) Score
- 6. Production Lifecycle Time (Acceptance of Referral to Date)
- 7. Program Compliance

Assigning Projects


 Applications with a designated Referral Entity (Contractor Name) noted on Page 2 are assigned back to that source, when possible.

EmPower contractors and referring agencies: Print your business or agency name in this box.

Page 2

- Applications from other referral sources are distributed as follows:
 - Screen by Contractor service territory (Zip Code)
 - Contractor distance from applicant's Zip Code
 - Then, Contractor capacity
 - Established program goal by month (120 per year, 10 accepted referrals per month, blended with contractor referrals and available program referrals)
