Details of Moderate-Income ASHP Incentive Study

This incentive is offered with Assisted Home Performance, thus follows the AHP guidelines on ASHP installations. Other grants, incentives, and funding are stackable.

Approach: Contractor and Program Team

- 1. Contractors fill out a web-form after finding and interest or need in an ASHP
 - 1. Customers sign the form
- 2. Research team downloads the results from the form and randomizes the household into the \$1k or \$3k groups
- 3. Research team sends notification emails to customer and contractor in two days time
- 4. When an ASHP is accepted, contractor deducts \$1k or \$3k from the installation price of the heat pump
- 5. Research team updates Incentive Tracker that shows that amount of funds available (committed projects)
- 6. Incentives are paid to the contractor directly after a project is deemed completed by AHP
