


Q&A - Using Text


Q&A - Using "Raise Hand" and Microphone/Phone

Extended Program Modifications

Extended through June 30, 2021:

EmPower New York

- Lifetime project cap increase to \$10,000
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) adder to offset the added cost of PPE necessary for comprehensive energy efficiency projects

Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR

- Increase in maximum subsidy per project:
 - For single family homes, the maximum subsidy is increased from \$4,000 to \$5,000 toward the cost of eligible energy efficiency measures
 - For 2-4 family homes, the maximum subsidy is increased from \$8,000 to \$10,000
- Increased income eligibility thresholds from 80% AMI to 120% AMI
- Incorporation of a direct install of energy efficiency measures at the time of audit

EmPower Pricing Survey

- NYSERDA will draft a survey for EmPower contractors to provide feedback and examples of price increases for building materials and measures due to Covid-19
- Furthermore, NYSERDA will review the feedback and adjust pricing as necessary

Green Jobs Green New York Financing – New Loan Products



Renewable Energy Tax Credit Bridge Loan

- >Available to finance federal and state tax credits and NYC Real Property Tax Abatement
- >Term of 2 years
- Interest rate based on geo-eligibility or documented household income
- >Balloon Payment (Principal and Interest) due at maturity
- >Payment by check or automatic withdrawal (ACH) only

Renewable Energy Tax Credit Bridge Loan (con't)

- >Minimum Loan amount is \$1,500; Maximum \$25,000
- >Subject to cost effectiveness SIR and 15-year payback tests
- >Can be combined with GJGNY Term Loan and Companion Loan or can only borrow Bridge Loan
- >Each loan will have separate documents and payments
- >Eligible for contractor advance payment

Companion Loan

- >Available only with NEW GJGNY Loan
- >Must fully utilize GJGNY Loan (\$25,000)
- >Loan amounts \$1,500 minimum, \$25,000 maximum
- >Interest rate is 6.99% (6.49% for ACH payment)
- >5,10,15-year terms available
- >No pre-payment penalty
- >Cost effectiveness

Companion Loan (con't)

- >GJGNY and Companion Loan will have separate loan documents
- >Available for Contractor Advance Payment Program
- >Financing of ancillary but necessary measures and/or health and safety measures
